Director's Note


Hello Neighbors,

Tellus Group Buys Land for \$1.5B Master Planned Community


Tellus Group closed on 970 acres for the first phase of the \$1.5B Sherley Farms project in Anna. The master-planned community, which is slated to include 3,000 homes just east of Highway 5, will offer expansive green spaces and a 65acre working organic farm as a cornerstone of the development.

The developer is working with the Sherley family and the city of Anna on plans for the community. Sherley Farms will feature health and wellness lifestyle programming, including a design that provides access to the city's trail systems.
