

Kroger is coming to Anna!

Big news for our growing community—Kroger has confirmed their plans to open a store at Rosamond Parkway and US 75!

Back in October, the Anna City Council approved an Economic Development Incentive Agreement with the Seitz Group to support a 27-acre retail project at this key intersection. That agreement paved the way for a 123,000 sq. ft. national grocer (hello, Kroger!) and 8 new retail outparcels—a major win for Anna's future.






Why do I need a building permit?

A building permit gives legal permission to start a construction of a building project in accordance with approved drawings and specifications.

The Simple Permit Process

- Talk to the local code official about your project
- Submit Application with plans of the proposed work
- Review Process by official to ensure compliance
- Receive Permit to begin construction
- Job-Site Inspections to ensure work follow plan and meets codes
- **Final Approval** provided by the official documenting all work is complete and done right
