What an incredible year of momentum for the Anna Community and Economic Development Corporations! I'm proud to present the Fiscal Year 2025 Annual Report—a reflection of a community growing with purpose and a shared vision for the future of Anna.

I am particularly thrilled to welcome Joey Grisham back as EDC Director, teaming up with exceptional staff members including Natasha Roach (Asst. Director) and Salena Tittle (ED Manager). Our staff members are outstanding, displaying dedication, expertise, and a steadfast commitment to serving our community with excellence. It is their tireless work that truly drives our progress, and we are fortunate to have such a professional and talented group of individuals working for the city.

This past year, Anna experienced dynamic growth in both residential and commercial markets. In line with our strategic focus on revitalizing the downtown district, the CDC and EDC announced future development—a key step toward shaping a vibrant downtown.

In 2027, we will proudly open the doors to Tender Smokehouse, The Gin, and Papa Gallo's Mexican Grill—three locally celebrated restaurants that will anchor our new downtown. These will be complemented by outdoor entertainment space designed to create a welcoming, walkable gathering place for residents and visitors alike.

We also made significant strides in expanding residential opportunities with the creation of the Linde Lane, Sherley Farms, Trinity Creek, and Oak Ridge Public Improvement Districts—further diversifying Anna's housing options and supporting the city's long-term growth.

In July, we hosted our 5th Annual Developer's Forum at the Anna Municipal Complex. This year's reimagined format featured engaging panel discussions highlighting developments underway in our downtown and along the Highway 75 corridor. The message was clear: Anna is the place to be for commercial investment and opportunity.

One of this year's landmark achievements was the grand opening of Home Depot, made possible through a strategic incentive agreement. This project reflects the growing commercial confidence in Anna and our commitment to attracting businesses that meet community needs.

As we look ahead to 2026, it's worth pausing to reflect on how far we've come. From a first-year revenue of just \$27,494 in 1999 to over \$3.4 million in 2025, our progress has been remarkable.

To our City Council, Board members past and present, staff, community partners and neighbors—thank you. Your dedication, vision, and belief in Anna's potential continue to drive our success.

Type B CDCs can fund all the same projects eligible for Type A, as well as parks, museums, sports facilities, and affordable housing. They were created to enable quality of life improvements.






